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Exceptions to compulsory vaccination

Conditions for exemption from compulsory vaccination:

Excluded from the application of the mandatory vaccination measure against COVID-19 are those citizens who have proven health reasons that prevent the vaccine from being carried out, namely:

- ∅ Severe allergic reaction
- ∅ Diagnosed allergy
- ∅ Thrombosis syndrome in thrombocytopenia
- ∅ History of thrombocytopenia
- ∅ Diagnosis of pericarditis or psychocarditis

Exceptions to compulsory vaccination

Competent bodies and procedure

- NoThe three-member committees in each Health District, which are recommended by a decision of their commanders, which can request and take into account the opinion of a competent person, of the committee, a doctor of a corresponding specialty.
- The requests for exemption from the obligation of eVaccinations are transmitted on a daily basis exclusively through the treating physician to an email address that is announced on the website of each Health District.

Details of the application

Necessary application details

The application includes complete information of the applicant as well as of the treating physician:

- ∅ Name and surname
- ∅ Social Security Registration Number (A.M.K.A.)
- ∅ Electronic communication address for sending the decision of the competent health committee
- ∅ Date of application for exemption
- ∅ Reason for exception

Attached is the medical certificate of proof of the exclusion with all the necessary information, as well as any other critical evidence.

Application schedule

Application deadlines

- Submission of applications for exemption from compulsory eVaccination for medical reasons to the competent health committees will take place until January 14, 2022.
- Applications are answered within an exclusive deadline of seven (7) calendar days. The decision is notified electronically, to the applicant and the treating physician.
- During the period from the submission of the application until the issuance of the decision by the competent health committee, no sanctions are imposed due to the vaccination.
- At January 28 those citizens who make a rejection decision should have made the first installment the fine is charged.

The attending physician keeps in a special file the answers of the competent health committees, to which he has access and the applicant.
